



Teamwork & artistic flair combine to create a giant masterpiece!

One of our most popular activities. Designed to demonstrate that teams can accomplish complex tasks only if each and every member of the team understands their task and gives 110%. We take a famous work of art (Van Gogh sunflowers) and project it on the wall.

Full size easels and artists canvasses are set up in the room. Paints, palettes, brushes and aprons are all provided. Team members must paint a small section of the picture on their own personal canvass (we have chopped the image up into sections).

At the end of the activity all the canvasses will fit together to form an exact and enormous replica of the famous work of art. Team members **MUST** communicate to share colours, scale, and to understand who is doing which bit.

The end result is always amazing; we end with a question, could you have painted that picture by yourself?

What will your team learn?

- The importance of understanding what the end result of a project will look like – “Seeing The BIG Picture”.
- Understanding exactly what your own contribution to the overall project is, and understand how this fits into the bigger picture.
- Understand what other team members are doing to achieve the overall aim, so that you can work together where objectives overlap and compliment each other.
- The importance of clearly communicated quality standards and performance objectives.
